WSP Annual Program Timeline for Placement Sites

Winter

Placement Site application released

Early February

Placement Site applications due (submitted using the JotForm platform)

March

Placement Sites chosen for the year and notified

May

WSP/Placement Site contract process initiated

May-July

WSP Program Coordinators begin conducting initial interviews with qualified Corpsmember applicants

June/July

WSP/Placement Site contracts due

July

Placement Site Mentors interview Corpsmember applicants

August

WSP staff offer conditional enrollment to Corpsmember applicants

October

WSP Corpsmember enrollment and 7- day Orientation in Fortuna. Afterward, Corpsmembers report and start their service term at the Placement Sites

Mid-November

WAVE & WOW! Five-day training for Corpsmembers in San Luis Obispo

August of the following Year
